

### French 3/4 and 3 IB Q3 Extra Credit Opportunity

**Assignments must be submitted between May 4-11. Assignments will not be accepted after 11:59 P.M. on May 11.** Below are the assignments and what is required to earn the minimum 3 points and what additional work is required to earn either four or five points. (Please note that to earn four or five points that you **MUST** also complete the assignment for the previous point levels.) **All of this work is OPTIONAL**, and you may choose to stay with your previous Q3 grade.

You are ineligible to participate in this grade improvement opportunity if you have: a 100 average in a Standard level class, a 103 in an Honors level class, or a 105 in an IB level class.

Project Description: Choose a male and female from each category, and answer the 10 questions for each.

Choose one male and one female from each category (up to 10):

Actor  
Athlete  
Historical Figure  
Scientist  
Musician

Must include:

- Picture of person (must be 10 DIFFERENT people)
- Answers **in complete sentences**.

Submission (turn-in) Directions: Submit your work via a DOCUMENT attached in an email to your teacher. In the subject line, you must include:

Student Name, class period, language level and Q3 Extra Credit  
(Example: Jones, Mary 5<sup>th</sup> period Spanish 1 Q3 Extra Credit)

Points will be awarded as follows:

5 different people = 3 EC points on Q3 final grade  
7 different people = 4 EC points on Q3 final grade  
10 different people = 5 EC points on Q3 final grade

PLEASE NOTE: points will ONLY be given if ALL questions are answered for ***each person***.  
If there are less than 10 sentences for any person, that person WILL NOT count towards your total.

For example, when you finish:

You will have **at least 50** total sentences for 5 people to receive **3** points

You will have **at least 70** total sentences for 7 people to receive **4** points

You will have **at least 100** total sentences for 10 people to receive **5** points.
